Recital Fee:

Your \$65.00 recital fee should be paid. With this fee, you will receive (1) one **FREE** recital ticket.

Tickets:

How much are recital tickets?

Early bird recital tickets are \$18.00 per person for ages 18+ and \$8.00 for children between the ages of 5 & 17 years old. Adult ticket prices increase by \$5 and child tickets increase by \$2 if purchased on or after Monday, May 20th. Children 4 and under are free but will have to sit in a parent's lap.

How do I purchase recital tickets?

Recital tickets go on sale on Wednesday, May 1st via our recital ticket website. All tickets must be purchased **online** through our recital ticket website. The website link will be sent to every family via email on Wednesday, May 1st at approximately 10am.

Is there a ticket limit?

No, there is no limit to how many tickets are purchased for your party. Seating is general admission, first come first serve.

When will I receive my 1 free recital ticket?

You will receive your 1 free recital ticket beginning on the week of May 13th.

Is the show being livestreamed? If so, how do I buy tickets for that?

Yes, the show is being livestreamed by AOK Pictures (Erik Krefeld). The livestream is available for purchase for \$25 per household. You can purchase the livestream ticket on the recital ticket website.

Showbiz Kids & Dance Company Ticket Policy: Misplaced, lost or forgotten tickets will need to be repurchased to enter the theatre. **THERE ARE NO REFUNDS FOR UNUSED TICKETS**. The doors will open 30 minutes prior to performance time. Anyone occupying a seat will need a ticket. Dancers **DO NOT** need a ticket. All dancers will be backstage in the dressing rooms during the show.

Recital Digital Video:

Am I able to purchase a digital video of the recital?

Yes, all shows will be professionally filmed, edited and available for purchase through the recital ticket website.

How much is a recital digital video?

The cost is \$35.00 for a digital copy of the show which will be on a flash drive. Please remember, flash photography and videoing are strictly prohibited during the performance. The digital video will provide entertainment forever!

Show Necessities:

Recital Rehearsal: Saturday, May 25th 10am-3pm:

What is recital rehearsal?

Recital Rehearsal is a very important part of the recital experience. It will be held at the Jennie T. Anderson Theatre. This is the first time the dancers and actors will see what the theater looks like, perform on stage, and get a true feel for what the show is going to feel like. You are required to arrive 15 minutes prior to 10am. We will not be able to wait for late arrivals. This is an important day so please take the time/effort to ensure an on-time arrival. *Please allow enough time for traffic.*

What does my dancer wear to dress rehearsal?

Dancers need to come dressed in regular class attire with all appropriate shoes. Dancers need to wear their regular class tights to the dress rehearsal and save their recital tights for the show. No makeup is required for dress rehearsal.

Am I allowed to watch dress rehearsal?

No, parents are not allowed to watch dress rehearsal or be in the theatre during dress rehearsal. You can either wait in your car or in the venue lobby area.

Stage Make-up and Hair:



Should my dancer wear makeup onstage?

YES! The stage is very bright, and the theatre is big! All performers will need to wear make-up for the show, so they do not get washed out by the stage lights. For our **younger performers** we recommend: mascara, blush and lipstick. Our **older dancers** should wear full stage make-up: eye shadow, eyeliner, mascara, blush, lipstick, and false eyelashes. We want all our performers to look their best on the big day! Glitter is fun too for that extra added touch! Male dancers do not have to wear makeup.

How should my dancer wear their hair on recital day?

Your child's hair should be in a bun at the crown of their head. Your child's hair should be as neat and clean as possible. Please make sure it is secured by using hair gel, bobby pins and hairspray. **NO fly-aways!** We would like for everyone to have a nice, uniformed look. This is a special day, and we would like you to make a special effort to look your best. If you have a hairpiece, bow, etc. please make sure that it is secure so that it does not fall off on stage.

The Big Day!!:

When should my dancer arrive at the theatre on Sunday, May 26th?

This is the big day your performer has worked for all year! You will need to arrive at the Jennie T Anderson Theatre 1 hour and 30 minutes prior to the performance (1:30pm). As you arrive at the theatre, you will bring your child to the left of the building to the performer's entrance. Please note that men are not allowed in the dressing room areas. When you drop off your child, you will need to check them in with a Showbiz Staff Member by initialing your name on our check-in sheet. After you check-in your dancer, please proceed back out the performer's entrance and head out to the main lobby entrance to enter the theatre and find a seat in the auditorium.

*Please note: there is no entering or exiting the theatre via the front of the stage. You must go outside and around the building – Thank you.

How should my dancer come dressed when they arrive at the theatre on Sunday, May 26th?

Please come in your first routine costume with hair and make-up done. This will help to make things run smoothly. There will be ShowBiz staff members to help direct you on where to go. We will have snacks and water while kids are in dressing rooms. You are not allowed in dressing rooms during the performance.

My dancer is in more than one class. Which costume should he/she wear first?

We will provide you with a document that has your child's name and the first costume they need to wear when they arrive at the theatre on show day. This will be given to you on the week of May 13th.

Am I allowed to pick-up my child during intermission or after they've performed their routine?

NO! All dancers will be released AFTER the recital is finished.

Am I allowed to come backstage during intermission and/or the recital?

NO! All parents and family members must stay in the audience or lobby area during intermission and/or the recital. Only Showbiz staff are allowed backstage.

Where do I pick-up my child after the show?

You can pick up your child at the performer's entrance where you dropped them off. You will need to sign them out by initialing your name on our check-in sheet. The same person who dropped them off must be the person who picks them up.

Are you selling any merchandise like recital flowers, t-shirts, etc.?

Yes, we are selling a variety of merchandise as keepsakes for your dancer. We are selling recital flowers, recital stuffed animal, & recital t-shirts. All these items can be purchased online via the ticketing website. When you purchase your ticket, don't forget to add the merchandise to your cart at that time. Limited quantities of these items will be sold at the recital venue for an increased price.

Seating:

When can we enter the theatre for the show?

We will open the theatre 30 minutes prior to show time. All seats are general admission. Please use common courtesy and cooperation when saving seats. No food or drink is allowed inside the venue.
